DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION: Air: Apply in 5 to 10 gallons of water per acre. Ground: Apply in 10 to 100 gallons of water per acre.

COMPATIBILITY: Compatible with most pesticides and fertilizers. A compatibility test is recommended if the desired combination has not been previously used. Add pesticide after all of the water has been added. DO NOT EXCEED: One quart per gallon of finished spray.

APPLICATION: Thorough coverage and wetting is desirable for optimum foliar spray results. Do not over spray causing runoff.

CAUTION: Do not use with copper sprays, oil, lime sulfur, spray lime or highly alkaline materials.

ALFALFA: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre one week after each cutting.

ARTICHOKES: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre early season; Repeat as necessary to improve plant vigor.

TOMATOES, PEPPERS, CUCUMBER, MELONS AND SQUASH: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre when plants are 3 to 4 weeks old and well established. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals.

ASPARAGUS, LETTUCE, CELERY, COLE CROPS (BROCCOLI, CABBAGE, ETC.): Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre when plants are well established after thinning or transplanting. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals, dependent on crop vigor.

BEANS, PEAS: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre at first bloom. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals.

ONIONS, GARLIC: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre at 6 to 8" height and repeat at 3 week intervals. CORN, SWEET CORN: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre at 18" height and again just prior to tasseling.

COTTON: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre pre-bloom and repeat as necessary during flowering and early square formation.

GRAPES: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acte pre-bloom and repeat as necessary during inwering and early square ionitation. GRAPES: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acte early season. Repeat as necessary to improve plant vigor. Do not apply within 60 days of harvest or after early fruit set (pea-berry size).

POTATOES: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre when plants are young during initial tuber formation. Repeat at 1 to 2 week. Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre after 4 true leaves have formed. Repeat as necessary at 1 to 2 week intervals. SMALL GRAINS (Wheat, barley, oats, etc.): Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre throughout growing season. CAUTION: DO NOT exceed

one quart per gallon of finish spray when combined with 2, 4-D amine and/or dicamba.

STRAWBERRIES: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre when first fruit buds show in the crown. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals for two additional applications.

HOPS: Apply 2 to 5 gallons per acre to vines in early season. Make a second application when the vines reach the top of the trellis. CITRUS, DECIDUOUS FRUITS & NOTS (Applies to cherries, plums, pears, peaches, prunes, almonds, walnuts, etc.): Use 1 to 2 quarts per 100 gallons diffue spray, 2 to 5 adlons per acre in concentrate spray in the early season pre-bloom and post-bloom as needed. CAUTION: DO NOT USE during late season on tree fruit whose maturity may be delayed or fruit color may be delayed by nitrogen application. DO NOT USE or Golden Delicious Apples during slow drying conditions.

FIRST AID
